

8. If at the expiration of two months after a race meeting a punters' club holds unclaimed money on behalf of a member, the club must pay the money to the Office for Recreation, Sport and Racing.

9. Within 21 days after the holding of a race meeting, a punters' club must lodge with the Office for Recreation, Sport and Racing a return in the following form completed by the punters' club:

10. A punters' club referred to in this schedule has the following characteristics:

- (a) a club is made up of persons who purchase tickets issued by the person conducting the club;
- (b) a ticket entitles the holder to membership of a club in respect of the race meeting in relation to which the ticket is issued;
- (c) the money paid for tickets forms a fund which is invested by the club on races;
- (d) any winnings are paid into the fund and the members of the club are entitled to share the fund in proportion to the number of tickets held by each member.

BY Road Process Order made on 3 November 1994, the District Council of Angaston ordered that:

1. Portion of the public road (Stockwell Road) generally situate dividing part section 3012 (CT 2884/184) from part section 211 (CT 2729/44), as more particularly described as 'A' on the Preliminary Plan No. PP6656/1994 be closed.

2. The whole of the land subject to closure be transferred to RODNEY MARK WILKSCH in accordance with agreement for transfer dated 27 June 1994 entered into between The District Council of Angaston and R.M. Wilksch.

On 25 November 1994 that order was confirmed by the Minister for the Environment and Natural Resources, conditionally on approval and deposit of the survey plan by the Registrar-General. The condition has now been fulfilled.
