

WATERWORKS ACT, 1932-1962: MORGAN-WHYALLA
COUNTRY LANDS WATER DISTRICT—LANDS ADDED
TO.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA { *Proclamation by His Excellency the Governor*
to wit. } *of the State of South Australia.*

(L.S.) EDRIC BASTYAN.

BY virtue of the provisions of the Waterworks Act, 1932-1962, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby:—

1. Declare that the lands described in the schedule hereto shall be added to and form part of Morgan-Whyalla Country Lands water district.

2. Declare that this proclamation shall come into force as from the 1st day of July, 1964.

THE SCHEDULE.

Comprising those portions of the hundreds of Hanson and Koorunga bounded as follows:—Commencing at the north-western corner of section 92, hundred of Hanson; thence southerly along the western boundary of said section and the production thereof across road to the north-eastern boundary of section 336; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of sections 336, 337 and 40 to the north-western corner of section 40; thence westerly across road to the northern corner of section 1029; thence north-westerly across road and along the north-eastern boundaries of sections 1030 and 43, crossing road, to the northern corner of section 43; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundary of said section for a distance of 624 links; thence north-westerly across road and railway reserve to a point on the south-eastern boundary of section 55 distant 680.7 links from the eastern corner of said section; thence north-westerly through section 55 along the north-eastern boundary of easement over portion of said section to a point on the north-western boundary of section 55 distant 478 links from its northern corner continuing north-westerly along the production of said easement boundary across road to the south-eastern boundary of section 813; thence north-easterly along said section boundary and across road to the southern corner of section 314 continuing north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of section 314 continuing north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of sections 314 to 307 inclusive to the eastern corner of section 307; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of sections 307, 320, 321, 465, 466, 469, 366 and 2283, crossing roads, to the south-eastern corner of section 2288; thence easterly across road to the southern corner of section 2287; thence generally north-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of sections 2287, 2286, 864 and 69 and across road to the south-eastern corner of section 68; thence generally easterly across road and along the southern boundaries of section 115 and part section 114 to the western boundary of road through section 114; thence generally northerly along the said road boundary and the eastern boundary of section 113 to a point in line with the southern boundary of section 798; thence easterly across road and along the said section boundary to the south-western corner of section 81, hundred of Koorunga; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of section 81 to its south-eastern corner; thence generally northerly along the western boundaries of sections 80 and 83 to the northern corner of section 83; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundaries of section 83 and part section 52 to the south-eastern corner of section 51; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of section 51 and closed road to the south-eastern corner of section 50; thence north-easterly across road and along the south-eastern boundary sections 41 and 42 and the productions thereof across road to the eastern boundary of road through sections 42 and 9; thence southerly along said road boundary to the north-western boundary of section 4 being a point on the boundary of Burra water district as previously proclaimed; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along the said water district boundary to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of section 2263; thence south-westerly across road and along said section boundary to the north-eastern corner of section 2253; thence south-easterly and north-westerly along the north-eastern and south-western boundaries of said section to the south-eastern corner of section 179; thence south-westerly along south-eastern boundary of said section to the north-western corner of section 177; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundaries of sections 177 and

172 to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of section 184; thence north-westerly across road to the north-eastern corner of section 184 continuing north-westerly and south-westerly along the northernmost boundaries of sections 184, 170 and part section 2222 to the north-eastern corner of section 88, hundred of Hanson; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundary of section 88 to its north-western corner; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of sections 88 and 89, crossing roads to the north-western corner of section 181, hundred of Koorunga; thence south-westerly across road and along the north-western boundaries of sections 182 and 183 crossing roads, to the north-eastern corner of section 91, hundred of Hanson; thence westerly along the northern boundaries of sections 91 and 92 to the north-western corner of section 92, the point of commencement.

Section 44, hundred of Wright, exclusive of all necessary roads.

1891-1960: HUNDRED OF ADELAIDE—RESERVE
DECLARED.

BY virtue of the provisions of the National Park and Wild Life Reserves Act, 1891-1960, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and upon the recommendation of The Commissioners of the National Park and Wild-life Reserves, do hereby declare the lands defined in the schedule hereto which were by a proclamation made pursuant to the provisions of the Crown Lands Act, 1929-1960, and published in the *Government Gazette* of the 3rd day of December, 1964, at page 1716, dedicated for the purposes of a wild-life reserve, and placed under the care, control and management of The Commissioners of the National Park and Wild-life Reserves, to be a wild-life reserve within the meaning of the said National Park and Wild Life Reserves Act, 1891-1960.

THE SCHEDULE.

Section 618, hundred of Adelaide, exclusive of all necessary roads.
