SOUTH AUSTRALIA { *Proclamation by His Excellency the Governor*
to wit. } *of the State of South Australia.*

BY virtue of the provisions of the Holidays Act, 1910, and all other powers me enabling, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby appoint Wednesday, the 7th day of September, 1932, a special day to be observed as a bank holiday within the town of Kyancutta, and Wednesday, the 21st day of September, 1932, a special day to be observed as a bank half-holiday from 12 o'clock noon within the town of Snowtown.

RESERVE DEDICATED AND PLACED UNDER CONTROL OF DISTRICT COUNCIL OF ELLISTON.

BY virtue of the provisions of the Crown Lands Act, 1929, and the District Councils Act, 1929, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby dedicate the Crown lands defined in the schedule hereto for the purposes of a recreation reserve, and place the said reserve under the care, control, and management of the district council of Elliston.

THE SCHEDULE.

Comprising the whole of section 32, hundred of Peachna, exclusive of all necessary roads.

WATER CONSERVATION RESERVE RESUMED.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA { *Proclamation by His Excellency the Governor*
to wit. } *of the State of South Australia.*

(L.S.) A. HORE-RUTHVEN.

BY virtue of the provisions of the Crown Lands Act, 1929, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby resume the Crown lands defined in the schedule hereto, beings lands which were, by proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* on the 28th day of April, 1892, dedicated as a reserve for water conservation purposes.

THE SCHEDULE.

Yorkey's Crossing Reservoir Reserve.—Comprising those portions of the hundred of Copley, gazetted April 28th, 1892, adjoining sections 210, 211, 212, 224, 225, and block A, exclusive of portions resumed August 3rd, 1916, and May 9th, 1918, and existing road.
