Portion of the Hundred of Telowie bounded as follows:

Commencing at the western corner of section 517 being a point on the boundary of Port Germein water district as previously proclaimed; thence north-easterly and northerly along the boundaries of sections 517, 355, 462, 446 and 507, crossing Baroota Creek and intervening road to the northern corner of section 507; thence north-westerly across road to a north-eastern corner of section 487 and continuing north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of sections 487 and 460, crossing intervening road, to the northern corner of section 460; thence north-westerly along the boundaries of allotments 2 and 1 of L.T.R.O. DISTRICT COUNCIL OF WILLUNGA

Section 435 Scheme

I, CHARLES MURRAY HILL, M.L.C., Minister of Local Government in and over the State of South Australia, the Minister of the Crown to whom the administration of the Local Government Act, 1934-1981, and all regulations made thereunder has been committed, do hereby authorise a scheme, pursuant to section 435 of the said Act, whereby the district council of Willunga will guarantee a loan to be raised by the Aldinga Senior Citizens' Club Incorporated.

THE SCHEME

The Aldinga Senior Citizens' Club Incorporated will borrow the sum of \$20 000 from the Australia & New Zealand Savings Bank Limited repayable over a period of fifteen years.

The proceeds of the loan shall be used for the construction of clubrooms on portion of a reserve at part section 397, hundred of Willunga, in accordance with plans and specifications to be approved by the council. The balance of the funds required to be provided from accumulated funds of the club.

The district council of Willunga will enter into an agreement with the A.N.Z. Savings Bank Limited, under the common seal of the council, to guarantee the repayment of principal and interest on the loan.
