

NATIONAL PARKS ACT, 1966: HUNDRED OF WARRENBEN—WARRENBEN NATIONAL PARK

SOUTH AUSTRALIA } *Proclamation by His Excellency the*

BY virtue of the provisions of the National Parks Act, 1966, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Lands, do hereby:—

1. Declare that the Crown lands defined in the schedule hereto shall be a national park.
2. Declare that the said national park shall be known by the name of "Warrenben National Park."

ABORIGINAL AND HISTORIC RELICS PRESERVATION ACT, 1965: HUNDRED OF KOORINGA—HISTORIC RESERVE DECLARED

BY virtue of the provisions of the Aboriginal and Historic Relics Preservation Act, 1965, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied in terms of section 17 of the said Act with respect to the land defined in the schedule hereto, and the consents required by the said Act having been obtained, do hereby declare the said land to be an historic reserve.

THE SCHEDULE

Paxton Square, being the whole of the land contained in certificate of title, register book volume 985, folio 115, and more particularly delineated in the plan deposited in the Lands Titles Office and numbered 1672, laid out as the township of Burra and being a subdivision of portion of section 1 and other land, hundred of Kooringa, county of Burra.

SEWERAGE ACT, 1929-1967—CONSTITUTION OF MURRAY BRIDGE COUNTRY DRAINAGE AREA

SOUTH AUSTRALIA } *Proclamation by His Excellency the*
to wit { *Governor of the State of South Australia*
 (L.S.) J. W. HARRISON

BY virtue of the provisions of the Sewerage Act, 1929-1967, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that the lands described in the schedule hereto shall be a drainage area for the purposes of the said Act, to be known as Murray Bridge Country drainage area.

THE SCHEDULE

Comprising that portion of section 75, hundred of Mobilong, bounded as follows:—Commencing at the northern corner of lot 7 Swanport Road, Murray Bridge; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of said road, crossing Homburg Drive, to the eastern corner of lot 62 Swanport Road; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of said allotment to its southern corner; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of lot 62 to the eastern corner of lot 61 Frances Street; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of lots 61 and 55 Frances Street to the north-eastern boundary of land comprised in certificate of title register book, volume 3527, folio 44; thence south-easterly along the said boundary to the eastern corner of said land; thence south-westerly along a south-eastern boundary of said land for a distance of 538ft. 5in.; thence north-westerly at a northern angle of 90° for a distance of 400ft. continuing north-westerly through said land to a point in line with a north-western boundary of said land; thence south-westerly along the production of said boundary to a south-western boundary of said land; thence north-westerly along said boundary for a distance of 210ft.; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of said land for a distance of 880ft. to the western corner of lot 38 Homburg Drive; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of lots 38 and 37 to the northern corner of lot 37; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of lot 37 to the western corner of lot 36 Gail Crescent; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of said allotment to the northern corner thereof; thence northerly across Gail Crescent to the western corner of lot 29; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of said allotment to the northern corner thereof; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of lot 29 to the western corner of lot 7 Swanport Road; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of said allotment to the point of commencement.
