BY virtue of the provisions of the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Acts, 1917 and 1918, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby set apart the areas of Crown lands respectively described in the schedule hereto for allotment, pursuant to the said Acts, to discharged soldiers.

THE SCHEDULE.

Comprising the whole of sections 255, 256, 257, 258, 259, and 260, hundred of Barossa, and sections 322, 323, 324, 325, 327, 328, 329, 330, and 331, hundred of Para Wirra, the above sections being exclusive of all necessary roads.

CERTAIN LANDS RESUMED.
