

WATERWORKS ACT, 1932-1978: ANGASTON AND WARREN COUNTRY LANDS WATER DISTRICTS—ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES

SOUTH AUSTRALIA } *Proclamation by His Excellency the*
to wit } *Governor of the State of South Australia*

(L.S.) K. D. SEAMAN

BY virtue of the provisions of the Waterworks Act, 1932-1978, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby:—

1. Alter the boundaries of Angaston water district by excluding therefrom the lands defined in the first schedule hereto.
2. Declare that the lands defined in the said first schedule shall be added to and form part of Warren Country Lands water district.
3. Alter the boundaries of Warren Country Lands water district by excluding therefrom the lands defined in the second schedule hereto.
4. Declare that the lands defined in the said second schedule shall be added to and form part of Angaston water district.
5. Declare that this proclamation shall come into force as from the 1st day of July, 1979.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

Comprising portion of the hundred of Moorooroo bounded as follows:—Commencing at a point on the south-eastern boundary of section 334 being the north-western corner of that portion of allotment A of L.T.R.O. Deposited Plan No. 989 contained (with other land) in certificate of title, register book, volume 2655, folio 93 and being a point on the boundary of Angaston water district as previously proclaimed; thence south-easterly and north-easterly along the boundaries of the land contained in the said certificate of title to the boundary of Angaston water district as previously proclaimed; thence north-westerly and south-westerly along the said water district boundary to the point of commencement.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

- a. Allotment 1 of L.T.R.O. Filed Plan No. 7850 of part section 678 and other land, hundred of Moorooroo, in the area named Angaston.
- b. That portion of section 678, hundred of Moorooroo contained (with other land) in certificate of title, register book, volume 2655, folio 93, heretofore included in Warren Country Lands water district.

BY virtue of the provisions of the Crown Lands Act, 1929-1978, and all other enabling powers, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby:—

1. Resume the lands defined in the first schedule hereto.
2. Dedicate the Crown lands defined in the second schedule hereto as park lands and declare that such lands shall be under the care, control and management of the district council of Elliston.
3. Reserve the Crown lands defined in the third schedule hereto as a depot reserve and declare that such lands shall be under the care, control and management of the district council of Elliston.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

Park lands, sections 373, 374, 375, 376 and 377, hundred of Ward, county of Musgrave, the proclamation of which was published in the *Government Gazette* of the 25th day February, 1971 at page 822, corrected by notice of erratum published in the *Government Gazette* of the 11th day of March, 1971 at page 1063.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

Sections 373, 374, 375, 376 and 377, adjacent to the town of Elliston, hundred of Ward, county of Musgrave, exclusive of all necessary roads, being the greater portion of the land defined in the first schedule hereto and more particularly delineated on the public map of the said hundred deposited in the Department of Lands at Adelaide.

THE THIRD SCHEDULE

Section 436, hundred of Ward, county of Musgrave, exclusive of all necessary roads, being the remaining portion of the land defined in the first schedule hereto and more particularly delineated on the public map of the said hundred deposited in the Department of Lands at Adelaide.

BY virtue of the provisions of the Waterworks Act, 1932-1978, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby:—

1. Alter the boundaries of Barossa Country Lands water district by excluding therefrom the lands defined in the schedule hereto.
2. Declare that the lands defined in the said schedule shall be added to and form part of Roseworthy water district.
3. Declare that this proclamation shall come into force as from the 1st day of July, 1979.

THE SCHEDULE

Comprising portion of the hundred of Mudla Wirra in the area named Roseworthy bounded as follows:—Commencing at the north-eastern corner of that portion of section 70 contained in certificate of title, register book, volume 1930, folio 27 being a point on the boundary of Barossa Country Lands water district as previously proclaimed; thence westerly along the northern boundary of the said part section and its production across railway land to the eastern boundary of allotment 21 of L.T.R.O. Deposited Plan No. 10749; thence northerly and north-westerly along the boundaries of allotments 21, 22 and 23 to the northern corner of allotment 23, thence south-westerly and westerly along the boundaries of allotment 16 of L.T.R.O. Filed Plan No. 5295 to the south-western corner of the said allotment and continuing westerly across Cliff Road along the production of the southern boundary of the said allotment 16 to the eastern boundary of section 84; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of section 84 to a point in line with the southern boundary of Gartrell Street; thence easterly across road and along the southern boundary of Gartrell Street to the boundary of Barossa Country Lands water district as previously proclaimed; thence northerly, easterly and again northerly along the boundary of the said water district to the point of commencement.
