Pest Plant Control Board Reconstituted

BY virtue of the provisions of the Pest Plants Act, 1975 and all other enabling powers, I, the Governor, upon the recommendation of the Pest Plants Commission and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby revoke the proclamation made on 29th June, 1978, and published in the *Government Gazette* on that same date at page 2234 and in lieu thereof establish a Pest Plant Control Board to control the area of the district councils of Light, Mallala, Owen and Tanunda and the corporation of the town of Gawler.

The Board is designated as the Central Adelaide Plains Pest Plant Control Board.

The Board shall be constituted and its business conducted in the manner provided in sections 19-26 inclusive of the said Act.

The Board shall comprise ten members, each member council appointing two members annually.

The members shall hold office subject to section 23 of the said Act.

A quorum shall consist of six members and no business shall be transacted at a meeting unless a quorum is present.
