AREA EXTENDED

SOUTH AUSTRALIA { Proclamation by His Excellency the Governor
to wit of the State of South Australia

(L.S.) D. B. DUNSTAN

PURSUANT to the Crown Lands Act, 1929-1980, and all other powers, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council:

1. Extend the area of the town of Thevenard by adding thereto the lands defined in The Schedule.

2. Declare that this proclamation shall take effect on the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.

THE SCHEDULE

That portion of the Hundred of Bonython, County of Way, bounded as follows:

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the Town of Thevenard, the proclamation of which was published in the *Government Gazette* of 3 January 1924 at page 2 and amended by proclamations published in the *Government Gazettes* of 17 September, 1925 at pages 681 and 682, 17 August, 1967 at page 1061 and 8 March, 1973 at page 856 being its intersection with the production easterly of the southern boundary of allotment 275, Town of Thevenard; thence easterly at right angles for a total distance of 126.00 metres; northerly at right angles for 51.50 metres; easterly at right angles for 63.00 metres; northerly at right angles for 74.39 metres; easterly at right angles for 105.00 metres; northerly at right angles for a total distance of 73.51 metres to the northern boundary of road south of and adjoining section 272; westerly along latter boundary to a north-eastern corner of the Town of Thevenard; thence southerly along portion of the eastern boundary of the said Town of Thevenard to the point of commencement.

PURSUANT to the Crown Lands Act, 1929-1980, and all other powers, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council:

1. Resume the lands defined in The First Schedule.
2. Cancel the land grant for Institute Reserve purposes, as defined in The First Schedule.
3. Dedicate the Crown Lands defined in The Second Schedule as a Community Purposes Reserve and declare that such lands shall be under the care, control and management of the District Council of Coonalpyn Downs.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

Institute Reserve, adjoining allotments 2, 4 and 26, Town of Tintinara, Hundred of Coombe, the proclamation of which was published in the *Government Gazette* of 16 May 1907, at page 914, being the whole of the land contained in Land Grant Register Book Volume 769 folio 151.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

Allotment 3, Town of Tintinara, Hundred of Coombe, County of Cardwell, exclusive of all necessary roads, being the whole of the land defined in The First Schedule hereto.

PURSUANT to the Crown Lands Act, 1929-1980, and all other powers, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council:

1. Resume the lands defined in The First Schedule.
2. Dedicate the Crown Lands defined in The Second Schedule as park lands and declare that such lands shall be under the care, control and management of the District Council of Central Yorke Peninsula.
