1. Declare that the said Act shall apply within those portions of the district council district of Mount Pleasant as are defined in the schedule hereto.
2. Declare that the provisions of Part VI. of the said Act shall apply to the remaining portion of the said district council district of Mount Pleasant.
3. Declare that this proclamation shall take effect from the date of the publication thereof in the *Government Gazette*.
