FRUIT AND PLANT PROTECTION ACT, 1968-1985

Notice Concerning the Pest 'Phyllocnistis citrella' or Citrus Leaf Miner

BY virtue of the provisions of the Fruit and Plant Protection Act, 1968-1985, I, Milton Kym Mayes, Minister of Agriculture, prescribe conditions set out below for controlling the entry into and spread of the pest *Phyllocnistis citrella* (citrus leaf miner) in South Australia.

Take note that for the purposes of this notice the following meanings shall apply:

- (1) 'citrus plant' means any plant or part of a plant other than the fruit, of the genera Citrus, Fortunella or Poncirus or the hybrids thereof.
- (2) 'department' means the Department of Agriculture, Department of Primary Industries or equivalent.

Part 1—Entry of Citrus Plants into South Australia

Pursuant to section 4 of the Act, I hereby prohibit the importation or introduction into South Australia of any citrus plant grown in the Northern Territory or Queensland, or certain parts of New South Wales (described in paragraph 2) unless:

1. In the case of a citrus plant grown in Queensland or the Northern Territory:

- (1) the growth-flush together with any mature leaves showing symptoms of infestation with citrus leaf miner have been removed from the plant.
