BY virtue of the provisions of the Crown Lands Act, 1929-1978, and all other enabling powers, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby:—

1. Resume the lands defined in the first schedule hereto being lands which were, by a proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* of the 29th day of July, 1971, at page 316, dedicated as a recreation reserve.

2. Dedicate the Crown lands defined in the second schedule hereto as a recreation reserve and declare that such lands shall be under the care, control and management of the corporation of the city of Woodville.

3. Dedicate the Crown lands defined in the third schedule hereto as a vehicle parking reserve and declare that such lands shall be under the care, control and management of the corporation of the city of Woodville.

4. Reserve the Crown lands defined in the fourth schedule hereto as a communications base reserve and declare that such lands shall be under the care, control and management of the corporation of the city of Woodville.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

Recreation Reserve, section 485, hundred of Port Adelaide and section 851, hundred of Yatala, county of Adelaide.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

Section 485, hundred of Port Adelaide and section 851, hundred of Yatala, county of Adelaide, exclusive of all necessary roads, being the greater portion of land defined in the first schedule hereto and more particularly delineated on the public map of the said hundred, deposited in the Department of Lands at Adelaide.

THE THIRD SCHEDULE

Section 500, hundred of Port Adelaide, county of Adelaide, exclusive of all necessary roads, being portion of the land defined in the first schedule hereto and more particularly delineated on the public map of the said hundred deposited in the Department of Lands at Adelaide.

THE FOURTH SCHEDULE

Section 501, hundred of Port Adelaide, county of Adelaide, exclusive of all necessary roads, being portion of the land defined in the first schedule hereto and more particularly delineated on the public map of the said hundred deposited in the Department of Lands at Adelaide.

BY virtue of the provisions of the Highways Act, 1926-1975, and all other enabling powers, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Commissioner of Highways, do hereby declare that the road situated in the hundred of Seymour and shown as the controlled access road in the plan contained in the schedule hereto and in the said plan shown shaded grey, to be a controlled access road and do hereby specify the routes and means of access by which persons, vehicles and animals may enter or leave the controlled access road to be those routes and means of access shown on the plan contained in the schedule hereto.
