

SUBDIVISION OF DISTRICT OF NOARLUNGA
INTO WARDS.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA, { *Proclamation by His Excellency the Governor
to wit. of the State of South Australia.*

(L.S.) TOM BRIDGES.

BY virtue of the provisions of the District Councils Act, 1914, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby—

1. Subdivide the district of Noarlunga into five wards, to be respectively named, Port Noarlunga Ward, West Ward, South Ward, East Ward, and North Ward, the boundaries whereof are as respectively described in the schedule hereto.

2. Determine that there shall be one councillor for each ward.

THE SCHEDULE.

Port Noarlunga Ward.—Comprising all that portion of the district west and north of the following boundary:—Commencing at the south-west corner of section 1, hundred of Noarlunga; thence southerly along the western boundary of section 11 and its production across road to the northern boundary of section 316; thence westerly along the north boundary of said section to its north-west corner; thence southerly along the west boundary of said section and its production to the northern side of road north of section 320, hundred of Willunga; thence easterly and southerly following the northern and eastern side of road adjacent to the River Onkaparinga to a point being the intersection of a line being the production easterly of the southern boundary of section 323; thence westerly along said line and the southern boundary of section 328 and its production across road to the eastern boundary of section 333; thence southerly along said boundary to the north-east corner of section 336; thence westerly along the northern boundaries of sections 336 and 335 to the north-western corner of the latter section; thence northerly along the western boundary of section 332 to a point being the intersection of a line being the production easterly of the south boundary of section 330; thence westerly along said line and said boundary, and its production to the western boundary of the district.

West Ward.—Comprising all that portion of the district south of Port Noarlunga ward, and south and west of the following boundary:—Commencing at the south-east corner of section 131, hundred of Willunga; thence northerly along the eastern boundaries of sections 131, 121, 111, 101, 91, and 81, and the production of the latter boundary to the northern boundary of section 71; thence westerly along the northern boundary of the latter section and its production to the north-eastern side of closed road north-east of section 339, hundred of Noarlunga; and thence north-westerly along said side of road and the north-eastern side of road north-east of sections 339 and 337 to the south-eastern corner of Port Noarlunga ward.

South Ward.—Comprising all that portion of the district bounded as follows:—Commencing at the south-east corner of section 131, hundred of Willunga; thence northerly along the eastern boundaries of sections 131, 121, 111, 101, 91, and 81, and the production of the latter boundary to the northern boundary of section 71; thence westerly along the northern boundary of the latter section to the eastern bank of the River Onkaparinga; thence northerly and generally north-easterly following the bank of said river to the eastern boundary of section 859; thence southerly along said boundary and the eastern boundaries of sections 585, 682, and 683 to the south-east corner of the latter section; thence westerly along the northern boundaries of sections 684 and 581, and across road to the north-east corner of section 514; thence southerly along the eastern boundaries of sections 514, 506, 30, 27, 29, and 504 to the south-east corner of the latter section; thence westerly along the northern side of road north of sections 487 and 486 to the south-east corner of section 128; thence southerly across road and along the eastern boundary of section 138 to its south-east corner; and thence westerly along the southern boundary of the district to the point of commencement.

East Ward.—Comprising all that portion of the district east of South ward; south-east of the south-eastern bank of the River Onkaparinga; and south of portion of the northern boundary of section 834, and the northern boundary of section 575.

North Ward.—Comprising all the remaining portion of the district.

RESERVE FOR DISTRICT COUNCIL PURPOSES.

BY virtue of the provisions of the Crown Lands Act, 1915, and the District Councils Act, 1914, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby dedicate the lands described in the schedule hereto as a reserve for district council purposes, and place the said reserve under the care, control, and management of the district council of Elliston.

THE SCHEDULE.

Comprising all that portion of the hundred of Ward, bounded on the south-west by the north-eastern side of Beach Terrace, town of Elliston; on the north-west by a line being the production north-easterly of the north-western side of the Esplanade north-west of allotment 167 to low-water mark on the sea coast; on the north-east by low-water mark; and on the south-east by a line being the production north-easterly of the north-western boundary of allotment 168 to low-water mark aforesaid.

APPLICATION OF THE FIRE BRIGADES ACT, 1913, TO
PORTION OF THE DISTRICT OF BERRI.

BY virtue of the provisions of the Fire Brigades Act, 1913, I, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said State, do hereby, upon the recommendation of the Fire Brigades Board, declare that the Fire Brigades Act, 1913, shall apply to that portion of the district of Berri under the local government of the District Council of Berri which is defined in the schedule hereto.

THE SCHEDULE.

Comprising that portion of the district council district of Berri, bounded as follows:—Commencing at the north-eastern corner of Channel Reserve north-east of section 76, Berri Irrigation Area; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern side of said channel reserve and the south-eastern boundary of section 76 and its production across road to the north-eastern boundary of section 77; thence south-easterly along said boundary and its production across road to the northern corner of reserve for school experimental purposes; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of said reserve and its production to a point being the intersection of a line being the production south-westerly of the southern side of Denny Street, Town of Berri; thence south-westerly along the production of said street to a point being the intersection of a line being the production north-easterly of the north-
