SOUTH AUSTRALIA, } *Proclamation by the Honourable Sir John Mellis Napier, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the said State, Deputy for and on behalf and during the absence from and until the return to the seat of Government of the said State of His Excellency the Governor.*

I, THE Governor's Deputy, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and make known that on the 19th day of November, 1969, His Excellency the Governor did, by an instrument under his hand and the public seal of South Australia, constitute and appoint me to be his deputy in South Australia during his absence from the seat of Government of the said State and until his return to the said seat of Government, and in that capacity to exercise, perform, and execute for and on his behalf during such absence and until such return as aforesaid, but no longer, all the powers and authorities vested in him by the Royal Letters Patent constituting the office of Governor of South Australia, excepting only the power of constituting and appointing a deputy: And all whom it may concern I require to take due notice thereof, and to give ready obedience accordingly.

NATIONAL PARKS ACT, 1966: HUNDRED OF SLEAFORD—NATIONAL PARK

BY virtue of the provisions of the National Parks Act, 1966, and all other enabling powers, I, the said Governor's Deputy, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister, hereby:—

1. Declare that the Crown lands defined in the schedule hereto shall be a national park.

2. Declare that the said national park shall be known by the name of Sleaford Mere National Park.
