The dog/s bark at:: - optional

- People passing by the property
- Other animals
- When I'm in my yard
- Other neighbours
- Nothing
- Other

When the dog/s bark it/they usually:: - optional

- Run along the fence
- Jump at the fence
- Sit or stand on the spot

I hope this information will help you to monitor the dog/s and rectify the situation as soon as possible.
