NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF
ROAD PROCESS ORDER

*Public Road, Section 265, Hundred of Blanche

BY Road Process Order made on 27 November 1992, the District Council of Mount Gambier ordered that-

1. portion of government road dividing parts section 265 (CT 208/153 and CT 2206/64) from lot 43 in Deposited Plan 22070 and parts section 265, Hundred of Blanche (C's of T 521/110, 207/18, 183/201) more particularly described as 'A' in the preliminary plan no.1384 be closed;
2. The whole of the land subject to closure be transferred to FRANCIS NEWMAN McDONNELL and LESLIE JAMES McDONNELL in accordance with agreement for transfer dated 3 August 1992 between the District Council of Mount Gambier and F.N. & L.J.McDonnell.

On 28 January 1993 that order was confirmed by the Minister of Environment and Land Management.

NOTICE UNDER THE ROADS (OPENING AND
CLOSING) ACT 1991

IN the matter of the Roads (Opening and Closing) Act 1991, Section 37, Subsection 1:

WHEREAS it is considered that The Echunga Wattle Co.
